

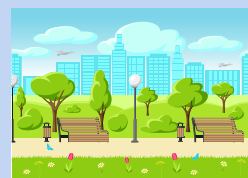
# Taxes... for what?

What happens to anyone who hasn't got a job, do they have to pay too?



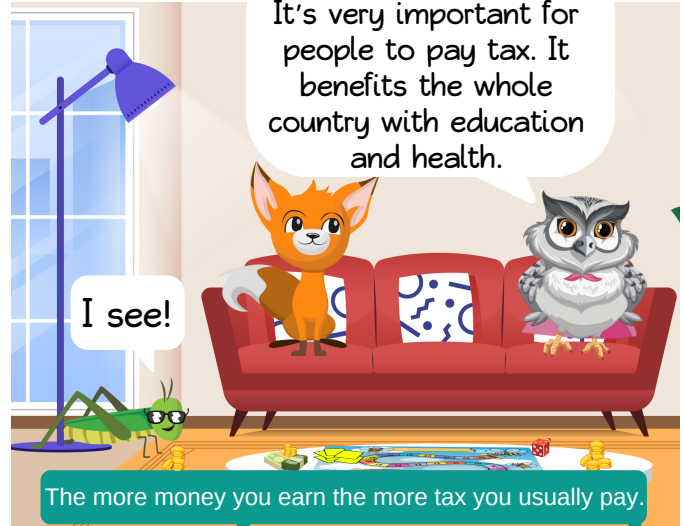
No, if they haven't got any money to live on, the government helps with tax money called 'benefits'.
